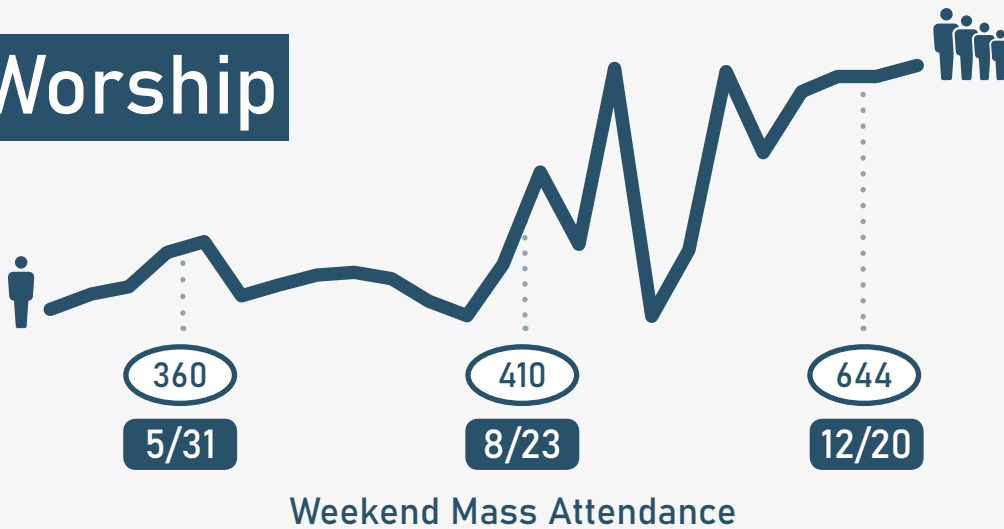

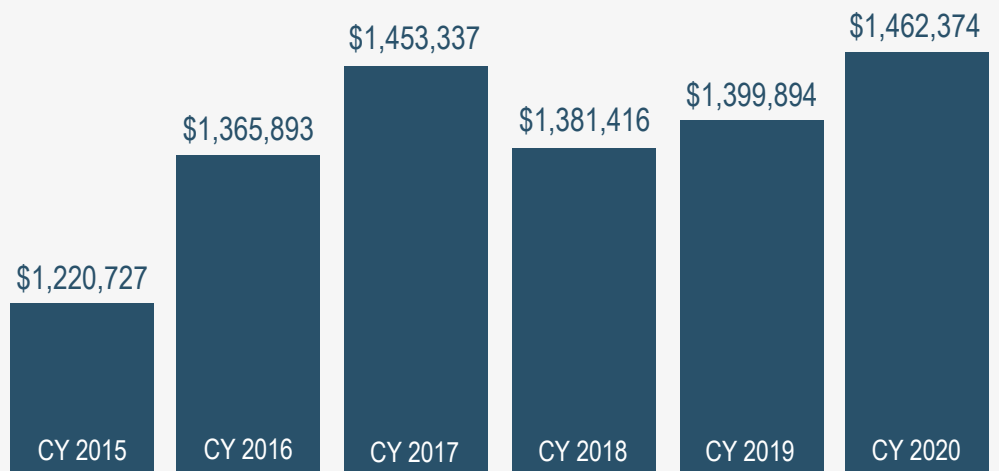

# Youth Formation

**"2020 ALLOWED US TO GROW IN CREATIVITY!"**

The Faith Formation team at St. Patrick's quickly transitioned from "business as usual" to full distance learning in the middle of a pandemic! We found new and creative ways to connect with youth and their families through virtual classes and frequent communication. We even found new ways to offer summer programming and engaged almost 100 youth! Halfway through the 2020-2021 school year, we are seeing 276 of our youth in person and 53 youth virtually. God is faithful and we are grateful to be working with such wonderful families!
